HUD determines the amount of each entitlement grant by a statutory dual formula which uses several objective measures of community needs, including the extent of poverty, population, housing overcrowding, age and housing and population growth lag in relationship to other metropolitan areas.

### **Eligible Activities**

CDBG funds may be used for activities which include, but are not limited to:

Acquisition of Real Property;

Relocation and Demolition;

Rehabilitation of Residential and Non-Residential Structures; Construction of Public facilities and Improvements, such as water and sewer facilities, streets, neighborhood centers, and the conversion of school buildings for eligible purposes;

Public Services, with in certain limits;

Activities relating to energy conservation and renewable energy resources; and provision of assistance to profit-motivated businesses to carry out Economic Development and job creation/retention activities.

### **Ineligible Activities**

Generally, the following types of activities are ineligible:

Acquisition, Construction or Reconstruction of building for the general conduct of government;

Political activities;

Certain income payments; and

Construction of New Housing by units of General Local Government.
