

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

For Program Year 2012, the City of Passaic anticipates to receive **less** than 2011 program year allocation of \$1,992,923.00 in funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the following programs: CDBG Program and HOME Program. To receive funds, the City must file an Action Plan, which includes the resources and activities to address the housing and community development need annually.

A public meeting has been scheduled to obtain views and proposals from citizens at the initial stage of preparing the Action Plan and to enable citizens the opportunity to comment on the City's community development programs and performance. Your ideas on projects to be funded by these grants are welcome. Examples of eligible activities are street repairs, social service agencies, historic preservation, residential and commercial rehabilitation, demolition, code enforcement, sewers, and property acquisition. These activities must primarily benefit lower income persons. Anyone interested in applying for funds should attend the meeting to receive an application package.
