**V. PUBLIC HEARING (ITEM 18) PUBLIC NOTICE:**

The City of Passaic will hold a public hearing on November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers located at 330 Passaic Street, Passaic, New Jersey. The purpose of the hearing is to discuss the City’s application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection’s Green Acres program. The application, seeking approximately \$1.7 million in grant and low interest loan funds, will be used to replace the field at Boverini Stadium with synthetic turf, thus expanding the local active recreation opportunities for residents.
