ALL PASSAIC RESIDENTS
EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY
NEW LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM

In order to comply with the State of New Jersey's "**new mandated**" storm water regulation requirements, the City of Passaic has instituted the following rules for the collection of leaves (Ordinance 1733-07) to comply with this law:

1. All property owners (residential, commercial, and institutional) **cannot** rake any leaves into the street.
2. All property owners who rake leaves must place this material in biodegradable bags (not paper or plastic bags). Leaves **must be** placed at the curb (after 6:00pm) the night before your pick-up day.
3. Leaves in biodegradable bags will be collected, once a week, the same day as your vegetative waste pickup. Collection will continue throughout the month of December, as weather permits.

Collection Dates Are As Follows:

4. Biodegradable bags are available at many garden centers throughout the area.
5. All landscapers, are **required**, and have been advised, that they must remove all leaves from their customers property and dispose the leaves as advised by Public Works within the hours of operation: 8:00am-3:15pm Mon-Fri. (See Ordinance 1732-07)
6. **Any property owner and/or landscaper that does not comply with the new regulations shall be subject to a violation not to exceed \$500 for property owners and \$1,000 for landscapers.**
