FREE Smoke Alarm Installations by Appointment



To have free smoke alarms installed in their homes, Passaic residents may contact the Fire Department by phone at **973-365-5688** or email at **info-fire@cityofpassaicnj.gov** to schedule an installation appointment.

Volunteers will be installing free smoke alarms in homes that need them, distributing fire safety information and talking to families about what they can do now to be prepared should a fire break out in their home. Volunteers will have proper identification. Please feel free to request to see ID. Only 1-, 2- and 3-family homes are eligible.

Our partners and volunteers want to help you, your family and our community stay safe.
Remember to test your smoke alarms monthly and practice your fire escape plan.
