**CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER)
July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023**

The City of Passaic has prepared its draft Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER). The CAPER concerns actions and accomplishments in Program Year 2023 with regards to the City's Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan was adopted to enable the City to apply to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funds under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and HOME Investment Partnerships programs. The five-year plan includes an assessment of housing and homeless needs in the City, a housing market analysis, and a strategic plan to address housing and non-housing needs. Also, a one-year action plan must be completed each year of the Consolidated Plan to describe the activities to be undertaken with funds available under the programs.

The CAPER is intended to enable citizens to understand how local programs contributed during the year toward meeting the needs identified in the Consolidated Plan. It consists of three basic parts: 1) a summary of resources and programmatic accomplishments, 2) the status of actions taken during the year to implement the City's overall strategy to address housing and non-housing needs, and 3) an evaluation of progress made during the past year in addressing identified priority needs and objectives.
